

Test-Kitchen torture: conducting the Dry-Egg Test



The Dry-Egg test was conducted over a period of five days, in Whitford's test kitchen in Elverson, Pennsylvania, during which time 414 eggs were cooked precisely the same way, one after the other.



Each egg was dropped into a frypan heated to 375°F/190°C, then cooked for 2.5 minutes before being turned over.



Amy Marshall, the Whitford technician who conducted the tests, has vowed she'll never eat another egg.
